## ABSTRACT PROGETTO

The aim of PEGASO is to build on existing capacities and develop common novel approaches to support integrated policies for the coastal, marine and maritime realms of the Mediterranean and Black Sea Basins in ways that are consistent with and relevant to the implementation of the ICZM Protocol for the Mediterranean. The Protocol does not apply to both regions, but PEGASO will use the model of the existing ICZM Protocol for the Mediterranean and adjust the ICZM platform to the needs of the Black Sea. As article 14 of the Protocol states, there is a requirement to develop new governance models that build on partnerships and participatory processes for the Mediterranean. The PEGASO project has been designed to assist in achieving this important aim, and to extend it to the Black Sea. The aim will beachieved by accomplishing five key objectives, responding to the topic ENV.2009.2.2.1.4 Integrated Coastal Zone Management. The second key objective of PEGASO is to make an integrated regional assessment for the Mediterranean and Black Sea coastal and maritime areas. The third objective of PEGASO is to refine and further develop efficient and easy to use tools for making sustainability assessments in the coastal zone. The forth objective of PEGASO will be to test and validate the assessment tools at regional and local scales to understand both global and cumulative local trends, and how they interact together in specific coastal and marine regions. The fifth objective of PEGASO is to establish and strengthen mechanisms for Networking and Capacity Development so as to promote transferability of knowledge.
