ABSTRACT:

The Low Carbon South-East Europe (LocSEE) project aims to build the capacities of public and other institutions dealing with climate change, and to strengthen the involvement of key stakeholders in policy development across the South-East Europe (SEE) region. The two-year project was launched in December 2012. It is co-funded by the South East Europe Transnational Cooperation Programme, which aims to improve the territorial, economic and social integration process in SEE. In light of the inclusion of Montenegro in the list of the EU candidate countries in 2012, a governmental priority is the approximation of the national legislation with the EU laws. To date however, Montenegro is at very early stage of formulating its national climate change policies. In order to strengthen its institutional capacity, the country joined the LocSEE project and works in a close collaboration with UNEP.
