The most common types of courses are:

Lecture (VO)	Courses in which the instructors convey knowledge by lecturing. At the end of the course you will get a grade after sitting an oral or written exam.	
Course (KS)	Specific questions will be discussed in class (lecturer and students).	
Lecture-Course (VC)	A combination of course and lecture. Usually there is an exam as well as class discussion and individual work.	
Lecture-Seminar (VS)	A combination of seminar and lecture. Usually active participation in the lecture and an essay are required.	
Proseminar (PS)	Introductory courses that are research-, theory- and project-oriented, which serve the purpose of academic discussion.	
Seminar (SE)	Research-, theory- and project-oriented courses which serve the purpose of academic discussion.
