

## **THESIS LABORATORY for the EGART Master's Degree programme**

For the year 2024, the thesis laboratory for the Master's Degree Programme in Economics and Management of Arts and Cultural Activities [EM3] will take place in the period: 12 February-11 March 2024.

### **Who it is aimed at**

The laboratory is addressed to all students enrolled in the Master's Degree Programme in Economics and Management of Arts and Cultural Activities [EM3] from both curricula ("Economia e Gestione delle Arti e delle Attività Culturali" and "Economics and Management of Arts and Cultural Activities").

Participation in the laboratory is facultative.

### **Objectives**

The aim of the laboratory is to introduce participants to the entire process of writing a Master's thesis, the resources available for the subject areas involved in the course of study and the relevant bibliographic research tools. In particular, students will be supported in the preliminary phase of learning the knowledge useful for the construction of a Master's thesis project.

### **Registration and participation**

Students can participate in the laboratory by filling in a registration form. Information about the current edition of the laboratory and the link to the registration form will be sent by email to all students enrolled in the Master's Degree Programme in Economics and Management of Arts and Cultural Activities [EM3] when the annual edition of the laboratory is activated.

Participation is online (on the Zoom platform) and is not mandatory, but once registered for the laboratory, attendance is recommended. For the 2024 edition, the laboratory lectures are held in English and the available material is provided in both English and Italian. Laboratory participants are given access to the materials available in Moodle and all the information needed to attend the laboratory.
