Economics: a department of excellence

The Department of Economics has for the second consecutive year been declared one of the 180 Italian Departments of Excellence. As a result, it will receive funding of seven million euros over the next 5 years from the Ministry of University and Research

VIVA (Venice Initiative on Vulnerability Analysis) is the new project for the department of excellence, the aim of which is to study how to deal with the issues related to social economic systems in transition, with special focus on vulnerable situations which might be exacerbated by exposure to exogenous shocks, thereby increasing inequality in diverse settings (economic, environmental, demographic, health etc). The distinguishing feature of VIVA will be a shared scientific approach both in experimental fields, such as field experiments and randomized studies, and in evidence-based policy and multidisciplinarity. The integration of research, teaching, and instruction will be reinforced by a broad activity of knowledge transfer between stakeholders, researchers and students

The specific aims of the project:

- 1) Reinforce a multidisciplinary approach and the department's mission as a reference point for the study, design, implementation, and evaluation of public policies to meet new vulnerabilities
- 2) Boost research by carrying out field experiments and randomized studies, especially in the field of public policy
- 3) Increase the Department's ability to attract international staff
- 4) Start up and structure constant interaction with stakeholders and the region for a proactive sharing of requirements and responses.

Over the next five years, thanks to the funding received, the Department of Economics will create an interdisciplinary research group around the VIVA themes, consolidate the department's infrastructure by making available considerable resources for the setting up of field experiments and the alignment of computing resources, and will deliver high quality teaching. All this while continuing and reinforcing the results and achievements reached in the previous five-year period of excellence.



Our research



The research activities at the Department of Economics are based on a solid tradition in economic studies dating back to the origin of Ca' Foscari University of Venice, which was founded in 1868 as the first Royal School of Commerce in Italy. The Department focuses on a wide range of research areas, such as:



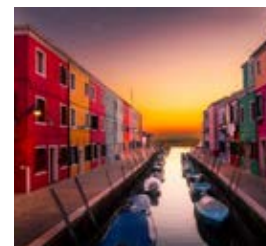
Behavioral and experimental economics

Our research focuses on market design and on the role of cooperation and competition within markets, in the labour environment and when considering social interactions overall, as well as the evolution and transmission of social and moral norms.



Econometrics, data science and quantitative methods

Our research is interdisciplinary and focuses on mathematical and statistical methods for economic, financial and econometric modelling, and their application to the different areas of economic and financial analysis in support of risk management, decision-making, and of the regulation of markets and institutions.



Economic geography, regional science and tourism economics

This research area analyses the nature, size, causes, consequences and which economic policy interventions may affect disparities in terms of economic prosperity at the geographical level both at the sub-national level (regional, urban or local) and in the international arena.



Economic theory

This research area focuses on the theoretical analysis of microeconomic and macroeconomic phenomena with attention to the study of financial and credit markets, contracts and auctions, networks, optimal taxation, economic growth and inequality, interaction between politics and economics, and market regulation.



Empirical economics and policy evaluation: labor, health, ageing and development

This research area focuses on issues such as pensions, immigration, wage distribution, labour supply, informal employment and unemployment, long-term care. This research area is also interested in investigating participation in welfare programs, saving choices, fertility and health choices as well as human capital investments, both when considering children and young adults, in developed and developing countries.



Environmental, resource and climate economics

This research area aims to develop and implement theoretical and empirical tools for the economic analysis of natural resource management, climate change and ESG risks, externalities, and associated policies and measures, both within the public and private domain.



Finance and Macroeconomics

This research area focuses on the functioning of financial markets, on the role of financial and insurance institutions and of sovereign debt and debt securities, on issues such as portfolio theory and asset pricing, fintech, catastrophic risks, longevity, insurance and insurance risks and the risk and structure of interest rates. The role that finance can play in contributing to ecological transition and sustainability is also investigated.



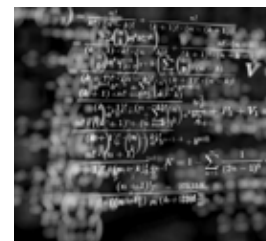
Human geography and Sociology

The themes and questions addressed in this area of research focus on the analysis and critical interpretation of the relationships between human groups, spaces and terrestrial environments. Places and territories are considered, in a geo-historical as well as contemporary key, in the light of environmental and cultural evolutionary processes.



Law

Research in the legal area focuses on the most topical and urgent issues of the law of obligations and contracts; the law of persons and family; fundamental rights, privacy and protection of personal data; public law; local authority law, administrative law; competition and market law; consumer law; intellectual property law; insurance law; business and company law, corporate crisis and insolvency law, accounting law; bank, finance and market law and regulation; international arbitration law; European Union law, national and international labour law, trade union law and welfare law; public, private and international trade law; tourism law; gender and law.



Mathematics and Statistics for Economics, Finance and Law

This research area develops theories, models and tools for the modelling of economic financial, social and legal phenomena and problems, both empirically, in which statistical analysis is used to test the validity of models, and methodologically, where theoretical analyses suggest interpretations and support decisions in complex environments.



Public economics and political economy

The themes developed in this area of research focus on the analysis of redistributive policies, of the public intervention in the fields of social security, health, education, and on the design and analysis of environmental and industrial policies.

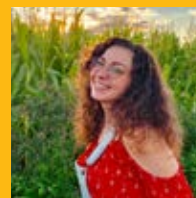

Course overview

This course is primarily aimed at students with an economics and business studies background who have a keen interest in quantitative methods and the mass use of data to maintain and increase companies' competitive advantage, emphasising the aggregate economic impact. The course aims to study the computational, mathematical and statistical aspects relating to the processing of digital data, which is nowadays produced by many different human, commercial and industrial activities, and their implications in the economic and business environment. Students on the "DABS - DATA ANALYTICS FOR BUSINESS AND SOCIETY" course will acquire data processing skills to interpret and analyse complex phenomena in the fields of economics, strategy, marketing, human resources, finance, accounting and social sciences in general. Furthermore, the course will provide advanced skills on machine learning techniques to extract patterns and predictive models from digital data. The programme is divided into two study paths, "Business Application" and "Fintech and Bigtech", which share the same quantitative training, with a strong basis of information technologies and the learning methods that are typical of artificial intelligence, statistical learning methods and mathematical optimisation methods to support decision-making and risk analysis.

Master's Degree Programme in
ECONOMICS AND FINANCE



Course overview

The Master's degree programme trains experts to master the main issues in the economic and financial field with a solid theoretical-quantitative and legal background. It aims to train students with expertise in financial markets, the main areas of financial intermediary management (credit, finance, treasury, securities, organisation, planning and control), financial investment management and the measurement and management of financial risks, financial consultancy and insurance, supplementary pensions and pension fund management, the organisation of internal processes and the administrative management of banks and financial intermediaries in general.

Students can participate in exchange programmes for 'double degrees', the Bloomberg Lab and associated Bloomberg courses and certifications as well as acquire CFA and AIAF certification.

The course of study is divided into two academic years: in the first year, the fundamental knowledge related to all the subject areas of the course of study is provided; in the second year, the specific training is completed, also with the free-choice subjects. The second semester of the second year is mainly devoted to the preparation and writing of the dissertation and to the compulsory curricular internship. The internship may be carried out in companies, public bodies and supranational organisations.

Graduates are also able to carry out freelance activities as financial advisors after having obtained the qualification, if required by the regulations in force. He will also have the qualifications to enter doctorates in Economics, Finance, Economics and Management and in the disciplines of Economic Law, in Italy and abroad.

Master's Degree Programme in ECONOMICS, FINANCE AND SUSTAINABILITY



Course overview

The Master's degree programme trains experts who possess:

- a high command of mathematical-statistical tools and a solid theoretical-quantitative background;
- a high knowledge of economic and financial analysis also in a policy perspective;
- strong legal and market regulation skills;
- a solid methodological-theoretical and modelling skills in the field of economics, both in research as well as professional contexts, to analyse the complexities of contemporary society and offer solutions to economic and social problems, in a dynamic perspective with a focus on innovations in the economic and financial spheres, as well as adaptation to climate change.

During the internship and thesis work, students have the opportunity to get closer to the research world by collaborating with teachers of the department, also financed with dedicated grants.

It consists of three curricula, completely taught in English:

- **Economics-QEM:** it trains economists with a solid background in economics; this curriculum is part of the Erasmus Mundus QEM programme and allows the participation in the Erasmus Mundus (QEM) program in collaboration with Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne (France); Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (Spain); Université Catholique de Louvain (Belgium); Warsaw School of Economics (Poland). The curriculum also welcomes many foreign students
- **Quantitative Finance and Risk Management:** it provides financial expertise in line with international standards in terms of content and level of preparation. Particular attention is paid to the tools of mathematical and statistical analysis applied to financial markets and institutions and to the study of complex financial instruments;
- **Sustainable Finance:** this new curriculum is the first in Italy and provides training in finance in line with international standards to integrate sustainability dimensions and seize opportunities arising from the increasing attention in finance on the impacts of climate change and the achievement of sustainable development goals.

This Master's Degree programme offers an interdisciplinary course, aimed at deepening the peculiarities of Global Development processes by integrating economic, finance and business knowledges with legal, quantitative, geopolitical and cultural competences, necessary to interact with international markets, with particular attention to emerging ones. The teaching programmes aim at training experts in the analysis of international markets and global value chains, as well as professional figures capable of supporting the international growth processes of companies and development cooperation projects with emerging economies. Teaching activities are complemented by workshops, seminars and meetings with entrepreneurs and managers from Italian and foreign companies, with the aim of promoting the development of the excellence present in the production systems of an area with a high international vocation. The programme provides scholarships for entry into the labour market thanks to the Luciano Iglesias Foundation (only for EU citizens).

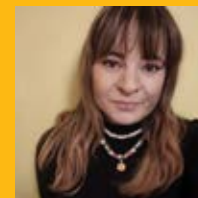

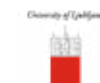
