

FAQ

What is a minor?

It is a didactic course composed of a cluster of three modules, worth 6 ECTS each, for a total of 18 ECTS.

How can I find the complete list of Minors?

Who can undertake the Minors?

The Minors are for students completing a Bachelor's Degree.

Why should I choose a Minor?

Minors allow students to amplify and complete their training, whether scientific or in humanities, looking at materials that they have not had the chance to deepen their knowledge on as it falls outside their specific training.

Can I choose any of the course offered?

You can choose from the Minors offered, except for those whose content is already part of their degree; on the webpage for each minor possible study programmes that Minors cannot be chosen for are indicated.

I am not a student, can I undertake Minors?

No the offer to undertake minors is only for students.

I am a Master's Degree student, can I undertake Minors?

The Minors are only offered to students completing a Bachelor's Degree: however, if you are a Master's Degree student you could find other initiatives dedicated to you, such as those offered by the Active Learning Centre at Ca' Foscari.

How can I enrol in a Minor?

You can choose a Minor and insert the modules that it is composed of by filling in their study plan. Normally, 2 of the 3 modules (12 ECTS) are inserted as optional credits, the third module (6 ECTS) is inserted as a supernumerary or additional credit. If you are enrolled in the Management Degree programme, all 3 modules of the Minor can be selected for the 18 optional credits provided by the programme. If the Minor has limited places available, admission will be subject to a selection process, and the process will be indicated in the specific course announcement (to be announced).

I have already filled my optional unit modules, but I also want to do a Minor – what can I do?

If you have already filled your optional unit modules with other exams, you can put the Minor course as a supernumerary or additional credit, as long as your degree programme allows you to have at least 18 ECTS.

When will the limited access Minors be published?

The admissions process for limited access Minors will be regulated by announcement regulations, that will be released from summer 2017: keep checking the page dedicated to Minors on the Ca' Foscari website: www.unive.it/offertaformativa.

When will I undertake the Minor?

On the dedicated web page, each Minor indicates the process of attendance and the expected calendar. Some activities may take place in summer to facilitate attendance.

Do I have to attend the entire course or can I choose to only insert some of the modules?

You must insert the entire Minor including all three modules into your study plan; to achieve the Minor certificate, you must furthermore pass all three exams. If you do not complete the Minor, the exams you have passed will not be recognised.

How will I be recognised for undertaking this formative course?

The Diploma Supplement will report the information of the Minor that you have undertaken and the activities that accompany it.

I am not a student, can I undertake Minors?

No the offer to undertake minors is only for students on degree programmes at Ca' Foscari. Some minors allow students to enrol on one or more of their modules that are put together to create single courses.

If I have some difficulty with the course, who should I speak to?

Each Minor will have a dedicated Tutor.
