3rd Ca' Foscari - University of Groningen PhD Exchange Seminar Series in Economics

The departments of economics of the Ca' Foscari University of Venice and the University of Groningen cordially invite PhD students from both institutions with recent research in any field in economics to submit their papers for presentation at the 3rd Ca' Foscari - University of Groningen PhD Exchange Seminar Series in Economics.

A joint scientific committee made up of faculty members from Groningen and Ca' Foscari will select the most suitable papers. This process is highly competitive as only two papers per department will be selected. Selected students will receive an invitation to give a seminar at the other university. The selected papers will be matched with experts from the other university who will act as discussants. Papers will be selected based on scientific quality and potential, and on the possibilities to find a good match with a discussant from the partner university. Upon submission, applicants are warmly invited to suggest potential discussants for their paper.

The aim of this seminar series is to give PhD students the opportunity to present their work in the early stages of their career at a high profile event, to receive in-depth feedback on their research, and to provide both students and staff members a platform to interact and exchange ideas with peers from the other university. The host institution will cover up to two nights of hotel cost. Other travel cost will be reimbursed by the sending institution.
