

Bonus for the calculation of the final Bachelor's Degree grade for students enrolled from the 2021/22 cohort

The different types of bonuses can be cumulated except for Joint/Double degree program, for which only the bonuses indicated above will be applied

- a) "normal" enrolled students are those who enrol without the recognition of any course credits, including those transferring from another university who make a change of course within the Ca' Foscari educational offer;
- b) training activities coming from:
 - achievement of another degree, university master's degree, PhD;
 - withdrawal or lapse from previous university programmes;
 - single courses taken prior to enrolment;
- c) for the purposes of attributing the bonus, each year of part-time enrolment is counted as half year of full-time enrolment;
- d) Internship abroad:

- bonus points are awarded for internships and substitute internship activities completed abroad;
- any internship completed in a country that differs from the student's country of residence or domicile is considered an internship abroad, regardless of the student's nationality;
- an internship completed partly in person (abroad) and partly remotely is considered an internship abroad;
- a minimum duration of the traineeship/traineeship replacement activity of at least one month is required for the award of bonus points;
- bonus is excluded for degree programmes that provide for compulsory internship.
