

Bonus for the calculation of the final Bachelor's Degree grade for students enrolled up to the 2020/21 cohort

The different types of bonuses can be cumulated ^(a)

- a)** Students participating in international programmes aimed at granting DOUBLE/JOINT DEGREE will not be awarded bonuses relating to Summer School activities, examinations or internship activities carried out abroad as part of a Double/Joint degree, regardless of the duration of their stay abroad. The Academic Senate has, however, resolved to grant these students, whose course of study includes a stay abroad of at least one year, a discount of one year in their career for the calculation of any speed bonus for obtaining the degree (see points 1.1, 1.2, 1.3);
- b)** "normal" enrolled students are those who enrol without the recognition of any course credits, including those transferring from another university who make a change of course within the Ca' Foscari educational offer;
- c)** training activities coming from:
- achievement of another degree, university master's degree, PhD;
 - withdrawal or lapse from previous university programmes;
 - single courses taken prior to enrolment;
- d)** for the purposes of attributing the bonus, each year of part-time enrolment is counted as half a year of full-time enrolment;
- e)** Internship
- bonus points are awarded for internships and substitute internship activities completed abroad;
 - any internship completed in a country that differs from the student's country of residence or domicile is considered an internship abroad, regardless of the student's nationality;
 - an internship completed partly in person (abroad) and partly remotely is considered an internship abroad;
 - a minimum duration of the traineeship/traineeship replacement activity of at least one month is required for the award of

- bonus points;
• bonus is excluded for degree programmes that provide for compulsory internships abroad.
