


# Ca' Foscari undergraduate or postgraduate students

1. From your Personal area click on "Immatricolazione – S3":




2. Select your active Degree programme:




3. Click on "Enrolment":




4. Select "Enrolment" and continue:




5. Select "Enrolment to unlimited admission Programmes" and continue:




6. Select "Minor":




### 7. Select the desired Minor:

You have completed the pre-enrolment procedure: if it is your first enrolment, you do not need to pay anything.

Lessons will be carried out with at least **ten participants**. If the Minor has a maximum number of participants, the admission of candidates will follow the chronological order. Enrolments received after the maximum number has been reached will be taken into consideration only in the event of withdrawal by some admitted candidates, following the chronological order as well.

At the end of the enrolment period, students who have applied will receive confirmation of enrolment.

Applicants will be notified via email if the Minor is not activated.
