Call for Applications for Teaching Staff mobility

2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26 Academic years

Art. 1 Purpose of the call and general regulations

1.1 This call regulates the application procedure for teaching staff mobility in the framework of the **Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility project** between **Ca' Foscari University of Venice**, and the following country and partner Universities:

Erasmus+ is the EU programme for education, training, youth and sport covering the 2021-2027 period. It offers a wide range of opportunities for students and staff to study, teach and train abroad and obtain credits that are then recognised by the sending institution.

1.2 The present call includes scholarships in the frame of two Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility project between Ca' Foscari University of Venice and its partner universities:

- the first project lasts 36 months, from August 1st 2022 to July 31st 2025;
- the first project lasts 36 months, from August 1st 2023 to July 31st 2026;

Art. 2 Mobility duration and available places

Under this call for applications, the following places are available for prospective candidates from Ca' Foscari University of Venice. For every destination, priority will be given to candidates proposing a Mobility Programme corresponding to the main objectives of the mobility project approved by the Erasmus+ Italian Agency, as detailed below. In particular, 20% of the maximum score envisaged for the "Proposed Work/research plan" selection criteria for every destination will be reserved to the above-mentioned coherence priority criteria (see below).

The present call for applications provides mobility grants for the 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26 academic years.

For ISCED 0222 Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on Archaeology of Armenian highlands; Physical anthropology

Armenia - Yerevan State University (YSU): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on Teaching Italian as a foreign language, Glottodidactics, the use of technologies in teaching foreign languages, the use of authentic materials to reflect on current Italian trends, the most effective teaching methodologies for teaching/learning Italian

Australia – James Cook University (JCU):

For ISCED 0222: Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on tourism translation, history of port cities

For ISCED 023: Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on language mediation and tourism and translation studies

Australia – University of Queensland (UOQ): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on time and human resource management and reporting in organizations that are structured in networks

Cameroun – University of Maroua (UOM): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on Teaching Italian as a foreign language; Glottodidactics, most recent language teaching methodologies, evaluation and use of literary texts to teach Italian, use of new technologies to promote innovative teaching

China – New York University of Shanghai (NYUSH):

Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on the application of the uniqueness of the Venetian context to new ecological models and symbiotic relationships with the ecosystem, with insights into ways of cultivating in cities

Cuba – Universidad de La Habana (UH):

Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on European perspectives on local literature, myth-criticism, studies on the Cuban fantastic fiction and new theories of analysis

Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on international migrations with the use of artistic languages, migration and urban sociology

Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on international migrations with the use of artistic languages, migration and urban sociology

Jordan – University of Jordan (UOJ) – Al Albayt University (AU) – Yarmouk University (YU): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on teaching Arabic as a foreign language and italian-arabic/Arabic-italian translation

Kosovo - University of Prishtina (UP): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on generative and theoretical linguistics

Mexico – CIDETEQ: Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programs on physical electrochemistry, electroanalysis, electrocatalysis, environmental electrochemistry, or nanomaterials electrochemistry, including concrete applications of electrochemistry and miniaturization of the sensing procedures.

For ISCED 052, 053: Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on oceanography and climate science

For ISCED 023: Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on teaching Portuguese as a second language and African literature in Portuguese

For ISCED 02,031: Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on anthropology and new trends in medical and environmental anthropology, as well as general anthropological theory

Qatar – Qatar University (QU): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on teaching Arabic as a foreign language and italian-arabic translation

Qatar - Doha Institute for Graduate Studies (DIGS): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on translatology applied to classical and modern literature and on the creation of a critical edition from the manuscripts

Singapore - Nanyang Technological University (NTU): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on local and regional perspectives in the study and management of coastal processes in terms of climate change

Trinidad and Tobago - University of the West Indies (UWI): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on Francophone and Anglophone Caribbean literatures, translation studies applied to the Caribbean and related European methodologies, application of digital humanities techniques

USA – City College of New York (CCNY): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on English and American studies

USA – University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on Brazilian Studies and the International History of Latin America, as well as a more European and less strictly Anglophone view of international relations

USA – Stony Brook University (SBU): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on English language and translation studies

Uzbekistan - Tashkent State University of Uzbek Language and Literature (TSUULL): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on general linguistics, Marco Polo studies with the innovative edge given by digital humanities, ethnomusicology

Uzbekistan - Uzbekistan State World Languages University (TSUULL): Priority will be given to candidates proposing mobility programmes on teaching Italian as a foreign language, Glottodidactics

ISCED codes eligibility are determined considering the area of study/research/teaching of the candidate (*Settore Scientifico Disciplinare*).

Changes in availability of places, duration and other terms of mobility can arise due to partner or Erasmus National Agency requirements. Slight duration changes might be possible due to project reasons, upon approval by the International Office.

Detailed information about type, duration and periods of mobilities is available in **ANNEX I**.

Depending on potential international crisis, mobilities may be postponed, but in any case, no later than the end date of the project (see art. 1.2). Ca' Foscari University of Venice will monitor the international situation and duly inform each beneficiary accordingly.

Art. 3 Admission requirements

3.1 In order to apply prospective candidates must be:

- *“professori di prima e seconda fascia, anche a tempo determinato”;*
- *“ricercatori universitari e assistenti di ruolo, anche a tempo determinato”;*
- *“docenti a contratto”;*
- *“assegnisti di ricerca”;*

3.2 The selected beneficiaries must hold the above-mentioned status at the moment of application and for the whole duration of the mobility period. The International Office must be informed timely of any possible change in their status.

3.3 The selected beneficiaries must carry out their mobility in a Partner Country different from the country of the sending organisation and their country of residence. Selected beneficiaries might be asked to provide proof of residence.

3.4 Language proficiency

3.5 Incompatibility

- Selected beneficiaries will not be allowed to benefit from any other grant provided by the European Commission for mobility in the same period (i.e., double funding).
- Candidates with a double nationality must specify the nationality under which they submit their application.

3.6 Ineligibility

- If, at any stage in the application procedure, it is established that the information provided by the applicant has been knowingly falsified, the candidate will be disqualified from the selection process.
- Selected beneficiaries who receive an Erasmus+ grant will fully or partially reimburse the EU grant if they do not comply with the terms of the grant agreement and/or if they fail to complete and submit the final online report, unless they are prevented from completing their planned activities abroad due to a case of force majeure.

Art. 4 Activities

4.1 Teaching assignments may come in various forms and take place as seminars, lectures, and tutorials. Actual teaching in this context should require the beneficiary to be physically present with the students. Teaching mobility may include providing training for the development of the partner HEI.

For mobilities for **teaching**, a minimum number of **8 compulsory hours** of teaching per week is required. Although email tutoring or any other forms of distance learning as well as preparation activities are highly encouraged, they do not count in the minimum number of 8 hours per week.

For mobilities for **teaching+training**, the minimum number of teaching per week is of **4 compulsory hours**.

For mobilities for **training only**, no minimum number of hours needs to be reported. Training activities may take the form of job shadowing, observation periods, training courses, etc. (excluding participation in conferences).

4.2 At the end of the mobility, in order to enhance the best impact of the project results, beneficiaries will be asked to provide:

- a short impact report on the template provided by the UNIVE International Office;
- the EU mobility survey;

Art. 5 Economic support

5.1 Beneficiaries will receive an individual support as a contribution to their costs during their mobility, which is specified in the table below.

5.1.1 Such individual support is intended to be a **gross payment - “compenso lordo”**, which will be subject to the

application of the Italian fiscal law and will be based on the following calculation criteria (respecting in any case the total amounts set by art. 2.1).

5.2 Beneficiaries will receive a travel contribution (1 round-trip flight ticket per beneficiary) according to the fixed amount assigned per destination, as follows:

Contributions for green travel are allocated if the beneficiary chooses sustainable transport that use low-emissions means of

transport for the main part of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling.

5.3 Erasmus+ selected beneficiaries might be required to purchase their international medical insurance with their own funds. Ca' Foscari University of Venice does not automatically provide health insurance for outgoing beneficiaries.

5.4 The mobility period must be carried out continuously and it must not be split into different periods. Therefore, during their mobility period beneficiaries must not carry out any teaching activity at Ca' Foscari. Beneficiaries will be invited to provide evidence of the activity performed during their mobility (photos, videos, syllabi, presentation slides, etc).

5.5 Selected candidates accepting the scholarship will sign a grant agreement for mobility listing their duties and responsibilities. They will be required to comply with the local admission requirements.

5.6 Administrative support:

Support in visa application, housing, accommodation will be supplied by each host partner university. Ca' Foscari University will assist beneficiaries in obtaining such support from the receiving institution.

5.7 This call is issued notwithstanding the current regulations on missions at Ca' Foscari University (Regolamento di Ateneo per le Missioni, art. 5.9), in particular concerning the maximum daily amounts and the method of payment.

5.8 Special needs support:

Extra-financial support may be available for beneficiaries with special needs. A person with special needs is a potential participant whose individual, physical, mental or health-related situation is such that his/her participation in the project would not be possible without extra financial support. The contribution will be awarded to beneficiaries with special needs upon request to Ca' Foscari University of Venice at the moment of acceptance of the grant and depending on the approval of the Erasmus+ Italian National Agency.

Art. 6 Admission procedure

6.1 Application

Applicants must submit their **application form** and **all required documents** (6.2) exclusively via the e-form available at the following link: <https://apps.unive.it/domandeconcorso-en/accesso/icmprof2023>.

Deadline: February 23rd 2024, at 1.00 p.m (13.00 Italian time zone). Any application received after the deadline **will not be accepted**.

- A confirmation e-mail will be sent to the applicants after their application has been successfully submitted.
- **All the attachments to the application MUST BE MERGED IN ONE PDF** file named after the Host University and the Host Country for which the application is submitted and the candidate's name and surname, following this scheme: **acronym.country.name.surname** (for example: *UOQ.Australia.Mario.Rossi.pdf*)

6.2 Required Documents

Teaching staff must provide the following documents:

- Mobility Programme for Teaching (Annex IIA to the Call), Teaching+Training (Annex IIB to the Call) or Training only (Annex IIC to the Call) signed by the applicant and by the Head of the applicant's Department (*Direttore/Direttrice di Dipartimento*);
- Copy of official language certifications or, if not available, self-declaration within the Mobility Programme (please state your language level in the section "Language skills");
- **Letter of interest or e-mail signed by the prospective academic supervisor at the host university stating the availability and willingness to host the applicant for his/her teaching/training programme.**

6.3. Total number of applications

Applicants can submit as many applications as the number of destinations available for this call, taking into consideration the requirements foreseen for each destination (language, etc). In such case one application per destination will be required and the personal priority ranking must be indicated in every application form. For further details, please carefully check Annex I.

6.4 The eligibility check of applications will be based on following criteria:

Applications will be rejected ONLY in the following cases:

- Submission after the deadline set by art. 6.1
- Missing Mobility Programme

- Missing signature by the Head of the applicant's Department on the Mobility Programme
- Final evaluation scoring less than 50 points

Applications will be declared not eligible ONLY in the following cases:

- ISCED code of the faculty member's study area not matching with requirements set by art. 2

Additional cases:

- In case of missing Letter of interest at the closing date of the present Call, the applicant will be considered eligible but automatically positioned at the end of the ranking. In the event that all eligible applicants for a specific destination do not submit a Letter of interest, they will be evaluated according to criteria specified in art. 7.2, and the selected candidate will have the possibility to integrate the document after the closing date of the call. In any case the Letter of interest will be necessary to proceed with the nomination to the partner University.

Art. 7 Selection process

7.1 Valid and eligible applications will be evaluated by a specific Evaluation Committee nominated by the Head of the Educational Programmes and Student Services Area and composed by 4 faculty members chosen among Department's Delegates to Internationalization (1 for each of the 4 Study areas represented at UNIVE, namely Hard Sciences, Languages, Business and Economics, Arts and Humanities) and 1 administrative staff member.

7.2 Valid and eligible applications will be evaluated according to the following criteria, which have been jointly agreed by the partner universities and the coordinating university:

7.3 The above-mentioned criteria will be evaluated starting from the following indicative rules. Selection committees will have the possibility to adapt them, if needed:

- **Impact of the proposed mobility on consolidation and extension of relations between partner Universities:** evaluation based on the section “Expected outcomes and impact” of the Mobility Programme - discretionary evaluation based on both written form and content of the section (relevance of the mobility for the relations between the Institutions involved and future joint projects);
- **Quality and coherence of the proposed workplan with the specific country-project objectives:** evaluation based on the section “Content of the teaching programme (proposed workplan)” of the Mobility Programme - discretionary evaluation based on both written form and content of the section (coherence with objectives clarified at art. 2 of the call);
- **Motivation:** evaluation based on the section “Motivation” of the Mobility Programme - discretionary evaluation based on both written form and content of the section (relevance of the mobility for the applicant’s career and current projects and research);
- **Language Skills:** evaluation based on the section “Language skills” of the Mobility Programme - discretionary evaluation based on language level declared and additional certifications, if applicable;

- **Previous mobility experiences:** evaluation based on Erasmus+ and Overseas mobilities carried out by the applicant during the previous 5 academic years

7.4 The final selection decision will consider also cross-cutting evaluation criteria such as gender balance, equal opportunities and participation of less advantaged groups providing a more equal and fair selection process.

7.5 In order to evaluate the applications, the Evaluation Commission may resort to the external support of one or more faculty who are experts in specific subjects. To do this, the Commission may choose one or more of the following institutional figures from the Ca' Foscari Departments: Department Director, Delegate for Internationalization, Education Delegate, Research Delegate.

7.6 At the end of the selection procedure, Ca' Foscari University of Venice will draft a ranking list of qualified candidates. A reserve list will also be defined and will include the names of eligible candidates who may be awarded a grant in case of withdrawals/drop-out of selected candidates.

7.7 All applicants will be notified by e-mail to their institutional e-mail addresses of the selection results as soon as the evaluation procedure has been concluded.

7.8 Selected candidates will receive a **scholarship offer** and are required to **accept or reject it in written** (no later than 3 days from the notification e-mail). For every selected candidate who renounces or does not accept within the deadline, **Ca' Foscari University of Venice** will nominate a candidate from the reserve list.

7.9 Appeal Procedure

- **Rejected applicants** who feel that a mistake has been made in the process or that their application has not been fairly evaluated can file a complaint to icm@unive.it not later than **2 days after the notification e-mail**, explaining their reasons.
- Complaints from applicants who have failed to satisfy all the eligibility criteria (e.g. who have not produced the required documentation, or have applied for a scholarship but do not meet the requirements, etc.), or have failed to satisfy them within the established timeframes, will not be taken into consideration.
- The appeal procedure can only come into play if a candidate feels that the Selection Committees have not handled his/her own application in line with the principles and procedures described in the call. In other words, the appeal cannot concern the decision itself, but only an alleged error made in the process.
