## INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to and in accordance with Article 13 of the EU Regulation 2016/679 ("Regulation"), we inform you that:

- d) the legal basis of the aforementioned processing is Article 6.1.e) of the Regulation ("execution of a task of public interest"). You can object to the processing of your personal data at any time by writing to the DPO at above mentioned contact details. The University will stop the processing of your personal data unless there are compelling legitimate grounds to carry on with the processing;
- e) the personal data provided in this form will be kept for the time stipulated by the regulations in force regarding the storage and archiving of administrative documentation;
- f) the personal data provided in this form will be processed by means of paper and computer tools and may be made available to national and/or EU public subjects/Authorities for the performance of the controls required by law and to subjects offering services to the University appointed as 'data processors'. - g) you have the right to obtain from the University, in the cases provided for by the Regulation, access to personal data, rectification, integration, cancellation of the same or limitation of the processing or to oppose the processing itself (Article 15 et seq. of the Regulation).
