COURSE CHOICE

The **course catalogue** is available through two different paths:

Overseas, SEMP, Eutopia students are free to select the courses from all Departments, according to the home University path, EXCEPT for the ones reported below in **red**

Erasmus+ students are divided into three main academic areas, and will be required to choose <u>70% of</u> the chosen courses must belong to the study field of the agreement under which they have been <u>nominated;</u> (you will receive this information from incoming.mobility@unive.it), the 30% is free, EXCEPT for the ones reported below in red

- *Department of Economics & Department of Management*: 70% of courses from these two departments, 30% of free-choice courses

- Department of Environmental Sciences, Informatics and Statistics & Department of Molecular Sciences and Nanosystems: 70% of courses from these two departments, 30% or free-choice courses

- Department of Linguistics and Comparative Cultural Studies, Department of Asian and North African Studies, Department of Humanities & Department of Philosophy and Cultural Heritage: 70% of courses from these four departments, 30% of free-choice courses),

Starting from <u>a.y. 2023/2024</u>, Incoming students CAN ALSO CHOOSE among the following courses:

- courses from the curriculum HOSPITALITY, INNOVATION AND E. TOURISM
- courses from Ingegneria ambientale per la transizione ecologica
- courses from the MA Global Accounting and Finance

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• courses from the MA Innovation and Marketing

Incoming students CAN ALSO CHOOSE courses from the following institutions:

- SIE. The Ca' Foscari School for International Education organizes Italian language courses and Englishtaught cultural courses for international students.Online registration is compulsory;
- <u>CLA</u>. The University Language Center organizes several language courses, such as English, French, German, Russian, Spanish. Online registration is compulsory;
- VIU. The Venice International University is an international network of universities founded by Ca' Foscari in 1995. Incoming students can attend their English-taught courses in the Island of San Servolo. ONLINE REGISTRATION IS COMPULSORY.

Students **do not need to register to courses** (except for SIE, CLA and VIU) <u>BUT THEY **MUST** SIGN UP TO EXAMS of ALL THE COURSES LISTED IN THE LEARNING</u> <u>AGREEMENT</u> (online procedure to be done about one week before the exam date).

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: starting from the a.y. 2023/2024, incoming students are no longer allowed to pick **single modules** out of a 2 modules course.

In other words, if they wish to take a course that amounts to 12 ECTS, and is split into two modules (6 out of 12 ECTS each), they will have to attend **both modules** and the exam will only be validated for 12 ECTS. If you fail to attend both modules, we will not be recognising the exam as passed.

Please find an example of a 12 ECTS course split into 2 modules. The course EM1A13 MODERN AND CONTEMPORARY ART is worth 12 ECTS, but split into two modules, each one amounting to 6 ECTS out of 12. If students wish to take this course, they must follow both modules, and will not be allowed to follow just one of them (not just MODERN ART or CONTEMPORARY ART, but **both**).

ACADEMIC YEAR

DEGREE PROGRAMME

When choosing a Degree Programme <u>CHECK</u> the course codes in square brackets: <u>For example:</u>

Philosophy, International, and Economic studies has the following code $-L\mathbf{I}6$, where \mathbf{I} stands for "Triennale", which refers to 1 cycle/undergraduate/1st (BA) level courses. Relazioni internazionali comparate has the following code $-L\mathbf{M}60$, where \mathbf{M} stands for "Magistrale", which refers to 2ndcycle/Master's degree courses.

PERIOD

Students have to identify the period of the scheduled mobility. The academic year is divided into two semesters: Autumn (first semester) and Spring (second semester). Additionally, for the Economics and Humanities Areas, each semester is divided into two terms.

Students must choose courses offered in the semesters corresponding to their mobility.

LEVEL

The level of the courses students wish to attend should correspond to their study level, as higher level courses often need pre-requirements. For ex., students attending a 1^{st} cycle/undergraduate/ 1^{st} level programme at their sending institution should choose only 1^{st} level (Bachelor's degree) courses, while 2^{nd} cycle students (Master's degree) are allowed to attend undergraduate (BA) courses.

However, if the home university agrees, Incoming students are allowed to choose courses from different levels.

In particular, it is advised to click on the "Programme" label and to scroll down the page in order to check the "Teaching language". We highly recommend students to choose only courses of which the teaching language matches with their English / Italian language proficiency.

Concerning courses description, Ca' Foscari recommends considering the following indications:

> Incoming students will not be allowed to attend two or more equivalent courses. In order to check this, click on the course webpage, then on the *"Professors and degree programmes"* label, scroll down to check the label *"Equivalent courses for other degree programme"*.



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EXAMS

Registration to exams is a compulsory procedure, to be done online, with the student's credentials, about one week before the exam date. The exact dates for the online registration are specified in your Personal Area, near to the course title or at <u>this link</u>. The Welcome Unit sends a guideline to all international students with the detailed procedure for the registration.

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

At the end of the mobility period, incoming students will receive their ToR, an official document with the details of each exam taken in Venice. <u>Only passed exams will be in the ToR</u>.
