# What is a double or joint degree programme?



Very international BA or MA programmes designed in cooperation with partner Universities all over the world



Students have the opportunity to spend part of their BA or MA at one or more partner Universities



At the end of the study path students receive either two diplomas (double degree) or only one diploma recognized by all partner Universities (joint degree)

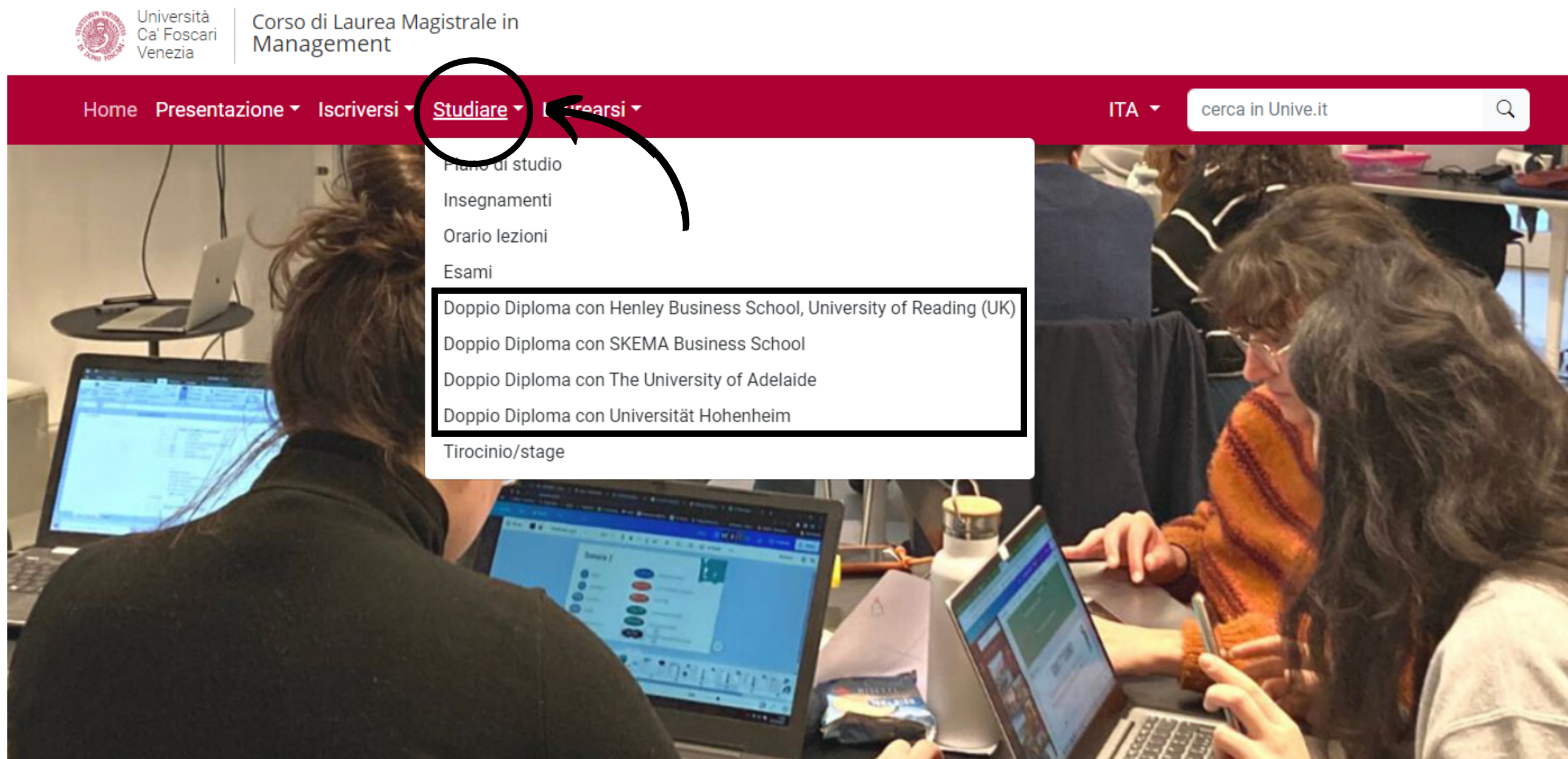

For most of the DJD programmes students can apply **during the first or second year** of a Ca' Foscari BA or MA

For some DJD programmes students must apply **before the enrolment**

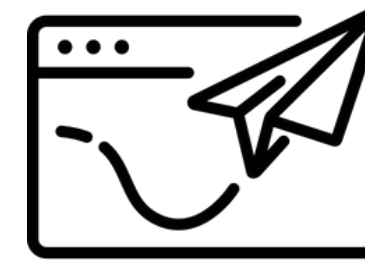
**Final selection results** will be published on the website of each degree programme within the webpage of the specific Double - Joint Degree.

Please note that the following Double - Joint Degree programmes **are not** managed through the call:

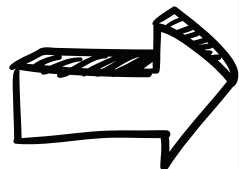

# Mobility grant



## Mobility grant

For mobilities in the 2023/24 A.Y.: min. 150 - max. 400 per month (see Annex B of the call)  
For mobilities in the 2024/25 A.Y.: amounts will be announced as soon as they are defined (see art. 3.1 of the call)

The amount of mobility grants will be defined based on the applicant's **ISEE (Equivalent Financial Situation Indicator)**.

**Annex B** of the call defines the monthly amount of the grant for each income range (from a minimum of 150€ to a maximum of 400€ per month) for mobilities taking place in 2023/24 a.y. only.

For mobilities taking place in 2024/25 or 2025/26, amounts will be announced as soon as they are defined (see art. 3.1 of the call)

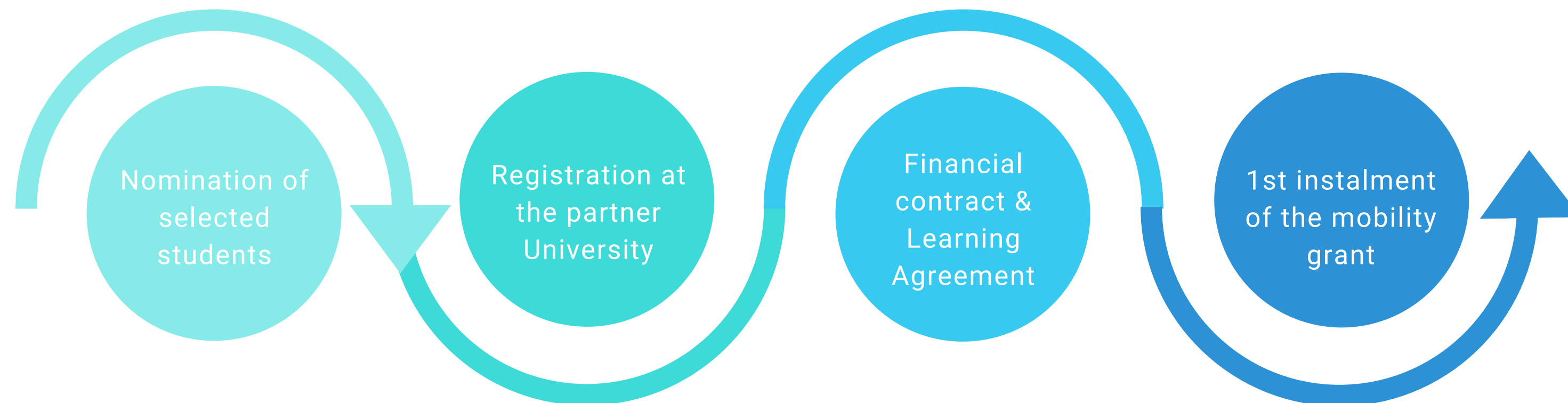

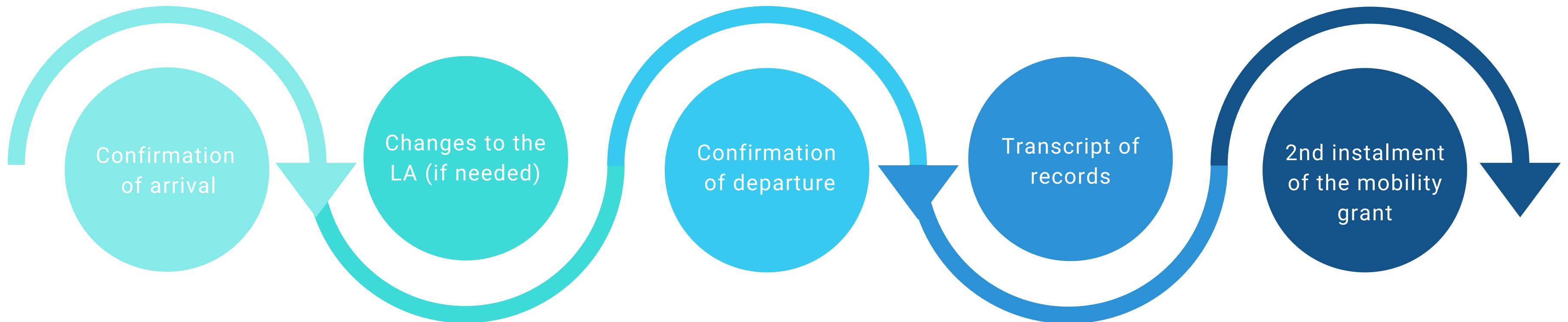






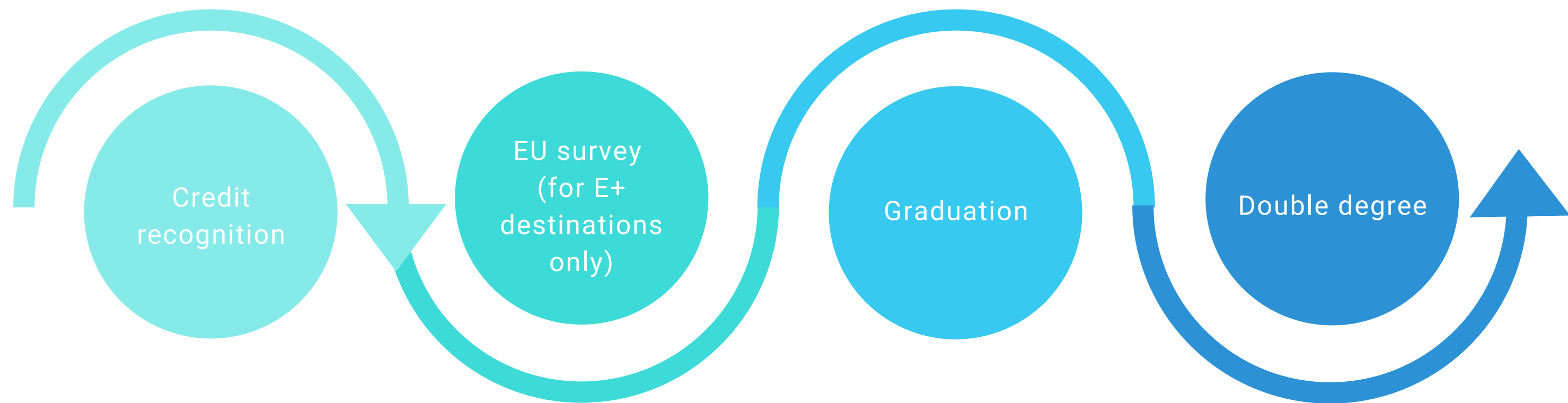
