WRITTEN EXAMS: RECOVERY INFORMATION

As established by the Academic Senate on 18 January 2022, the university is scheduling special exam recovery sessions for **students who belong to specific categories** and who for **documented reasons** were **unable to take one or more written exams** during the current exam session (10 January - 5 February 2022).

Students will be allowed to take exams during this **exam recovery session**, which will be held **in person**, provided that they **meet the following criteria**:

they must have signed up for a written exam and, at the date of the exam, possessed the requirements necessary to take the exam online (having tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 or being in isolation). However, they could not take the exam because even though their situation was documented, they were unable to provide the university's offices with the documentation required before the deadline by which students were allowed to take the exam online or were inserted into online exam lists.

Student requests will be examined and exam recovery dates will be published at the end of the ordinary exam session.

We take this opportunity to remind you that, depending on each student's situation, requests must be sent to the following address:

- a. students who are in quarantine or self-isolation (having tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 or having come into contact with a person who has tested positive) should contact the relevant campus (campus.economico@unive.it, campus.linguistico@unive.it, campus.scientifico@unive.it, campus.umanistico@unive.it, treviso@unive.it), stating their personal data, the degree programme they are enrolled in, the exam they are supposed to take, the professor, the date and the documented reason for which they cannot not take the exam;
- b. students who cannot not travel to the university because they are in a place that does not allow people to travel (for example, they are in a red zone or have recently travelled to a foreign country from which quarantine is mandatory upon arrival in Italy) should contact the address onlineexams@unive.it.
