As far as you know, we informed you that the curriculum of the Japanese language program for international exchange students was changed from the fall semester of 2022.

The number of Japanese language classes per week = 10 classes

1 class in Tokai University = 100 min

Weight of one Language subject in Tokai University = 1 credit (Japanese credit accumulation system)

Weight of one Non Language subject in Tokai University = 2 credits (Japanese credit accumulation system)

\* students will be allowed to take a maximum of 6 credits (equivalent to 3 classes) of non-language classes.

<Important!!!>Regarding the proof of Japanese language proficiency, please read carefully.

To apply for the Intensive Japanese Language Program, your Japanese language proficiency must be level N5 (or higher) in the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT). There are no beginner classes.

-Applicants must meet one or more of the following conditions.

1) JLPT N5 or higher.

- If you have the certificate of JLPT, please submit it.

2) Have studied Japanese for a total of 150 astronomical hours (1 hour = 60 min) or more at educational institutions (college, high school, or Japanese language school). Please note that only contact hours must be included.

- Please submit a letter from your home university or Japanese language teacher to certify that you have studied Japanese for a total of 150 astronomical hours (only contact hours) or more at educational institutions.

\*Required information: Course Title•Period•Total Number of Astronomical Hours

(Ex: Japanese Reading & Writing•2022 Spring•75 contact astronomical hours,

Presentation in Japanese•2022 Fall•75 contact astronomical hours, .....

TOTAL: 150 contact astronomical hours)

3) Have Japanese language skills equivalent to 1) or 2) above.

Applicants who do not meet either 1) or 2) above must submit the evidence of your Japanese language proficiency.

- Your score on the TTBJ's SPOT 90 is 30 or higher (please submit the pdf of your score).
