Call for Applications for the Assignment of Three Visiting Scholar Positions at the Department of Asian and North African Studies

The present document in English is intended solely as a summaryof the main provisions contained in the official Italian version of the notice of competition, which is available on the Department's website. The Italian text is the only legally binding version and, in the event of non-conformity with the present document, it shall prevail.

Description

The Department of Asian and North African Studies at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites applications for no. 3 Visiting Scholar positions.

The Department will provide a lump-sum contribution of €3,000.00 for the performance of the research activities mentioned in paragraph 2. Additionally, a maximum of €500.00 may be granted as a travel allowance. The travel contribution will be paid once, in proportion to the distance between the Department and the candidate's place of employment, as follows:

Up to 750 km: €175
Up to 2,000 km: €275
Up to 3,000 km: €400
Over 3,000 km: €500

The Visiting Scholar shall carry out activities independently, without predefined working hours, in accordance with the research program. An internal supervisor will be assigned considering the research themes proposed.

The Visiting Scholar will be expected to give lectures and seminars on their research work, addressed to students and faculty members of the Department.

Who can apply

The selection is open to highly qualified Italian and international experts and scholars with a significant academic or professional curriculum, and affiliated with non-Italian entities.

The selection is open to scholars intending to spend a period ranging from 30 days to 24 months at the Department, for the purpose of developing their own research project. The period of stay must begin no later than December 31st, 2026.

Deadline for submission of applications: May 30th, 2025, at 12.00 noon (Italian time)

How to apply:

Applications and supporting documents must be submitted via email to ricerca.dsaam@unive.it, with the subject line 'Bando Visiting 2025', by the deadline indicated in the call as published on the University's Official Online Notice Board

Candidates should submit:

- A scanned copy of a valid ID;
- A signed scientific (academic) -professional curriculum vitae, including a declaration of accuracy pursuant to D.P.R. No. 445/2000 and authorization for the processing of personal data in accordance with applicable laws (Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 and EU Regulation 2016/679);
- A research project, written in either Italian or English, to be developed during the stay at the Department;
- A declaration of willingness to give lectures/seminars during the stay at the Department

Applicants will receive a confirmation email by the end of the next business day following submission. Please note that technical support requests will be accepted up to 24 hours before the deadline.

Applications will be evaluated on a scale of up to 100 points, based on:

- Interdisciplinarity of the project;
- Willingness to hold seminars;
- Candidate's curriculum vitae:
- Structure and topics of the research project.

The final ranking will be published on the University's Official Online Notice Board by June 20th, 2025.
