For a tenure-track position as assistant professor, we require a Ph.D. degree in management or a related field. The application package should consist of a cover letter, a CV, the job market paper, up to two additional papers (published or unpublished), a research statement, a teaching statement, and three letters of reference.

For a tenured position at the associate or full professor level, we require a Ph.D. degree in Management or a related field, a strong publication record in top journals in Management or a related field as well as international visibility within the academic community.
