<p>The project prepared several volumes for publication and made substantial progress. The focus was on the Ilyenkov and Hessen-book-projects. It has successfully established two Open Access book series Verum Factum: Studies and Sources on Political Epistemology and Knowledge Hegemonies: Studies and Sources with Edizioni Ca' Foscari. They are now online and the work on the first volumes started.</p> <p>Political Epistemology, Cosmology</p>

<p>The first objective was to start the book series and work on the first volumes. The second objective was a substantial contribution to the Edition Open Access series, in particular the preparation of a ready-to-print collective volumes dedicated to Evald Ilyenkov and Boris Hessen respectively, to bring them to publication. At least a presentation of the research results at an international conference.</p>

<p>The project has successfully established two Open Access book series Verum Factum: Studies and Sources on Political Epistemology and Knowledge Hegemonies: Studies and Sources with Edizioni Ca' Foscari. They are now online and the work on the first volumes started. The research projects on Evald Ilyenkov and Boris Hessen have been brought further towards publication. The volume on Boris Hessen has been postponed in coordination with the co-editors and the translator to publish first the Ilyenkov volume, which was brought to completion to start peer-reviewing (possible date of publication: September 2019). The Hessen project has been continued and a text has been written which will be included in the volume. The book is completely transcribed and a translator has been appointed. Since the translator has to work on both projects, it was decided to start with the Ilyenkov volume. There has been a meeting with the co-editors of the Hessen-volume. Another translation of a secondary text on Hessen from German to English is completed for inclusion in the volume. The Ilyenkov volume will be published this year (September) and the Hessen volume beginning of next year, before the possibly prolonged contract would end. Furthermore another volume is ready for Knowledge Hegemonies series and the internet presence of the ERC-Group Early Modern Cosmology has been created.</p> <p>I presented the results of the research at several occasions (Moscow, London, Helsinki, see below)</p>
