Poster display:

Posters will be displayed on double-sided freestanding boards. The surfaces of the boards are in cardboard and posters can be attached using thumbtacks, which will be provided. The boards can ONLY accommodate posters up to A0 size max. (1189 mm x 841 mm) IN PORTRAIT FORMAT ONLY. We apologise for not allowing landscape, but portrait allows for the maximum number of posters to be accommodated at AARG2018.

Posters may or may not be laminated but should at least be printed in high quality.

Tips/guidelines:

The AARG2018 poster session has been designed to allow a summary of completed projects, preliminary results of a project, a follow-up or extension of a previously published project, or a report on a specific aspect of a larger project.



Posters should have a high visual impact, normally focusing heavily on graphics and overall design and not be text heavy, as viewers will be standing and walking around to view/read the posters within limited time.

Posters should be created using a digital output size of A1 or A0 and printed on high quality papers of these respective sizes to avoid resolution issues. Do not work on a small digital size and expect to be able to print a poster in a larger size, as it will become pixelated and blur.

As a guide, the following font sizes are generally recommended:

Title: Arial, 75—80pt, bold and centered.
Sub-section headings: 36pt Arial bold
Body text: use at least 20–25pt Arial, justified text.
