

#### **Course structure**

- 50 or 70 hours (online) of language grammar and skills
- Direct streaming lessons using Zoom
- Remote teaching activities on the virtual platform Moodle
- Self-learning activities



Attendance and certificates

- Attendance compulsory (at least 70%)
- > Exit test
- Attendance certificate with final grade
- No credits
- Only one free Italian language course for each degree programme



#### **Enrolment**

- We receive the names of the eligible students from our Ca' Foscari offices
- We send an enrolment form by email
- Enrolment opens in October 2021

## Italian language at CEFR levels (A1-C1)

- ➤ 30 hours of historical and sociolinguistic aspects of the Italian language
- > 50 hours of language grammar and skills
- > 6 ECTS



## Italian language

#### Language and linguistics module (30 hrs)



- 2 x 90-minute lessons per week (8 weeks)
- > Final exam after the course is over

#### Language practice (50 hrs)



- 2 x 2.5 hour lessons per week (10 weeks)
- Final test (oral and written) + mid-term evaluations

## Standard Italian language courses

Online Italian Language Courses



#### 3 x Sessions

September-December
January-March
April-June

### Our standard courses are currently entirely online.

This is intended to allow students to begin or continue their language training in Italian, despite the safety measures enforced to reduce the current pandemic.



#### International Certification CILS

- The **Ca' Foscari School for International Education** (SIE), in agreement with the Università per Stranieri di Siena, is an accredited centre for the <u>CILS examinations</u>;
- The CILS exam is a **proficiency examination** and an official recognition of the attained level of **linguistic competence of Italian as a foreign language** (from A1 to C2).
- The CILS exam "CILS Due-B2" is recognized by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry
  of Education, Universities and Research. Students who have obtained CILS Due-B2 are exempt from
  the language test organized by Italian universities.
