

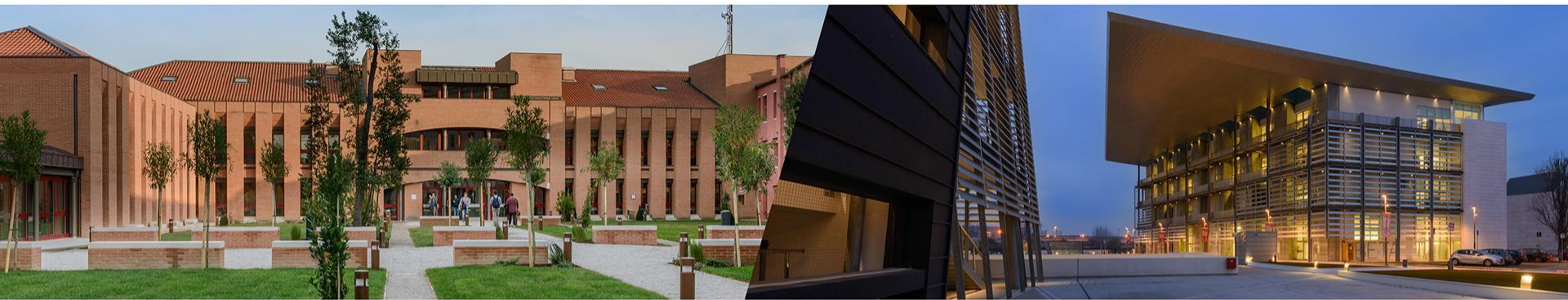

- If you have feedback on the class make sure you address it properly

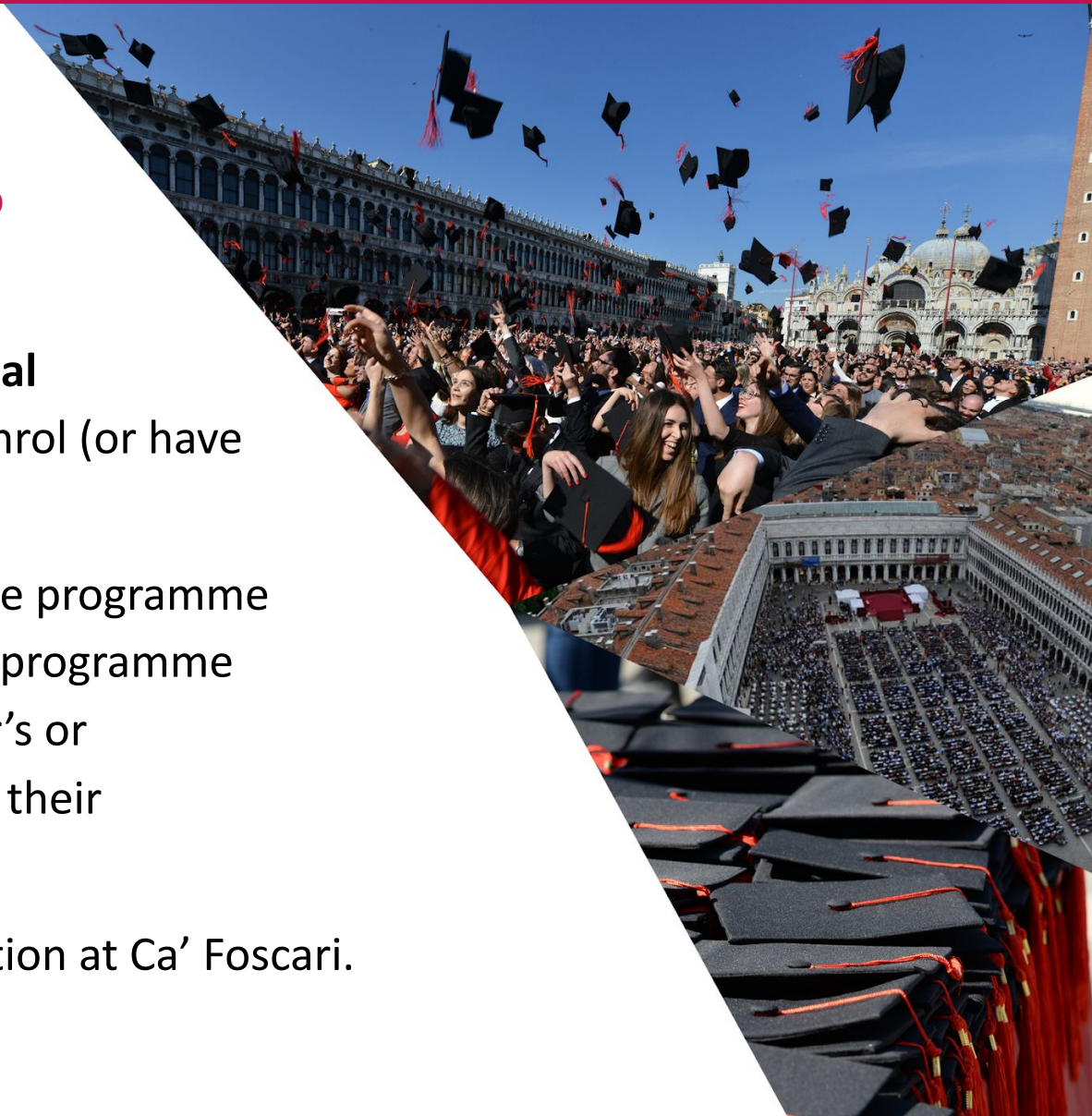


Who is a Degree Seeker?

Online enrolment

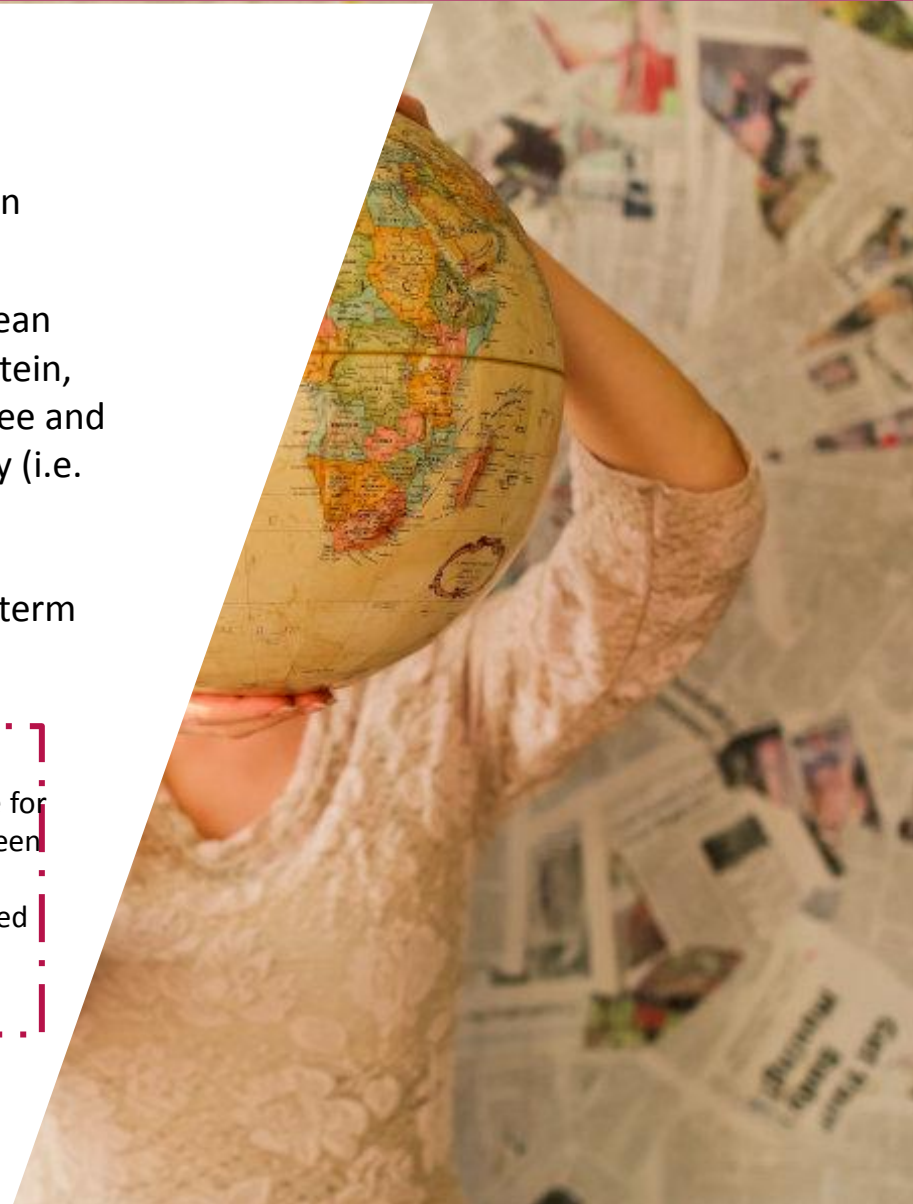
Procedures and deadlines for enrolment vary depending on where you come from:

- **EU students and equivalent** are citizens from European Member States and from Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Swiss Confederation, Republic of San Marino, Holy See and citizens of non-EU countries regularly residing in Italy (i.e. holding a permit of stay valid for enrolment).
- **Non-EU students who require a visa** are citizens of non-European countries who require a visa for long-term stay in Italy valid for enrolment.

Why are there different deadlines based on nationality? As a consequence of the pandemic emergency, procedures for visa issuance for non-EU citizens have been completely revised and all deadlines have been postponed. These changes forced all the involved institutions to adjust their internal procedures accordingly. For this reason, Ca' Foscari decided to postpone deadlines for enrolment to give extra-eu students the due time to obtain their visa and complete the subsequent steps.

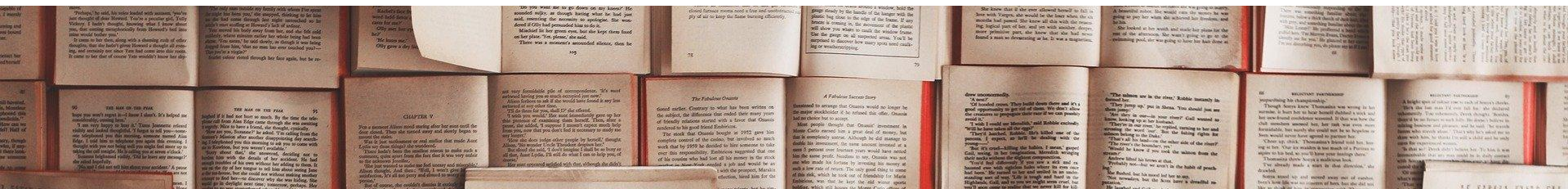

- Language certificates;
- (for non-EU citizens) Italian visa for study;
- (for non-EU citizens already residing in Italy) Italian residence permit.

Master’s degree programmes

- Bachelor’s degree final Diploma and transcript of records;
- Statement of Comparability issued by CIMEA OR Declaration of Value issued by the Italian representatives abroad OR Diploma Supplement issued by the qualification awarding institution;
- Language certificates;
- (for non-EU citizens) Italian visa for study;
- (for non-EU citizens already residing in Italy) Italian residence permit.





Tuition fees

Two instalments for 2021/22 academic year:

- First instalment of €700 to be paid by 17/12/2021
- Second instalment to be paid by 16/05/2022

Tuition Fee Waiver and CRUI/MAECI scholarship

You will be required to pay only:

- €173 (Regional fee)
- €16 (revenue stamp)

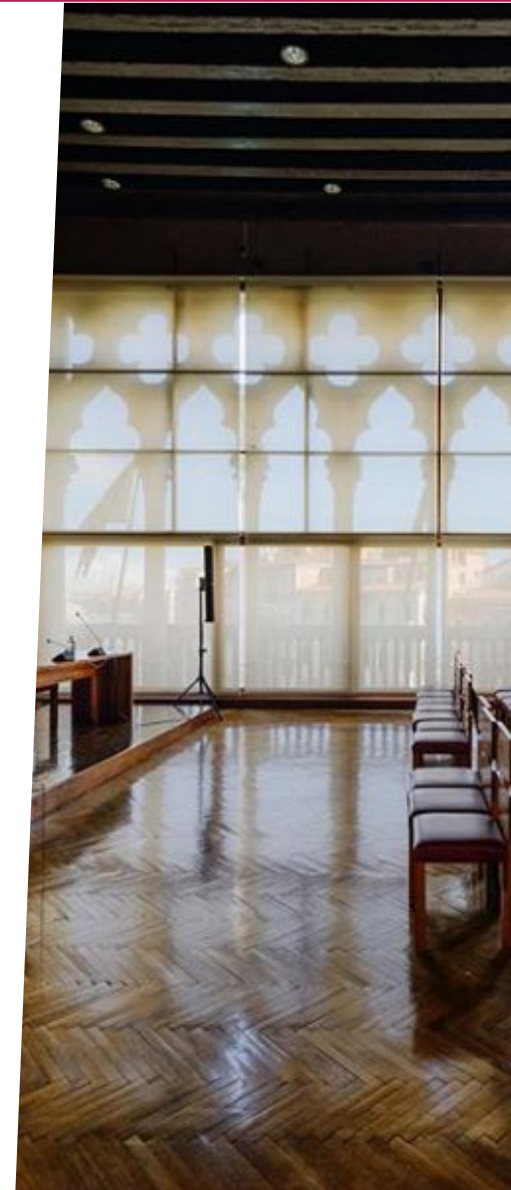
Grading System

The Italian grading system works on a scale from **18** to **30**. 18 is the lowest passing grade (sufficiency). 30L is the highest grade (30 cum laude).

ONLY if you pass the exam of a course will you obtain the relevant credits. Exams usually give 6 or 12 credits.

If you do not pass an exam, you can take it again..

If you do not pass an exam, this cannot be registered in the Grade Booklet, nor in the Transcript of Records. Therefore, you will not obtain the equivalent credits.

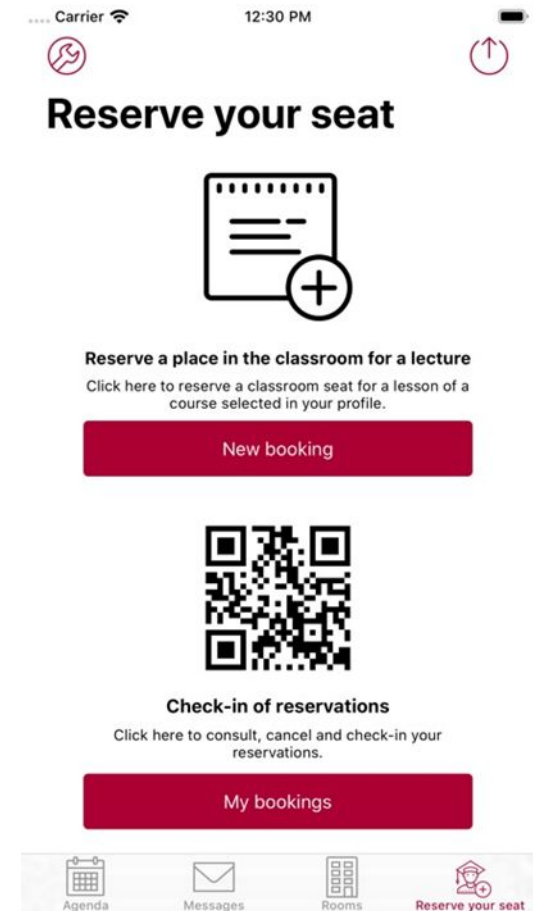
How will class attendance work?

This semester, you will be able to attend classes both in person and remotely.

To protect everyone's safety, **the capacity of the classrooms will be reduced to 50%** of the available spots and you will be able to **reserve your place** in the classroom through an **online system** (<http://orari.unive.it/AgendaWebUnive>) or the **app MyUniVE**. The app can be used to **reserve a place** in the time slots of the different classes you want to attend in person. **Upon entering the building**, your **temperature** will be taken and the access will be permitted by showing to the reception, or by presenting to the staff assigned to monitoring access, the **QR Code** generated through the app/website as a proof of reservation.

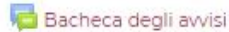

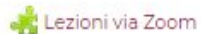

- If you are a **non EU citizen** and you wish to stay in Italy for **more than 90 days**, you must apply for a **residence permit** (permit of stay - permesso di soggiorno).

- The CartaConto card will be your Student ID, useful for universities services, or to buy your bus pass.
- It can also be used as a **prepaid card**.
- It will be ready in a few days after your enrollment has been finalised by the Counseling and Welcome Unit. You will receive an email to pick it up.

Tax code (codice fiscale)

- The **tax code certificate** is mandatory for administrative issues: opening a bank account, registering to the Italian health service, registering an accommodation, etc.
- Moreover, the tax code is needed to acquire the so called “Covid Green Pass”
