Dr Valeria Kolosova

"Ethnobotany of Karelians and Russians in Karelia: Fieldwork and Ethnographic Data"

Dr Kolosova will talk about her experience during the expeditions to Karelian Republic in Russia (interviews, herbarium), work in archives and libraries, and how we used it in writing articles. She will especially underline the difference between the official point of view on medicinal and edible wild plants of the region and the local people's opinions and practices.

Dr Nataliya Stryamets

"Ethnobotany of Bukovina: cases from Carpathian mountains in Ukraine and Romania"

Dr Stryamets will talk about the ethnobotanical study she conducted among two ethnic groups, both divided by a border, discuss the influence of social-political scenarios on use of wild plants and mushrooms for various reasons e.g. food, medicine, ethnoveterinary and cultural. The results demonstrate both qualitative and quantitative differences in plant use among groups divided by the border.
