Experience Venice, Italy this summer

The SIE Summer School in Italian language and culture is aimed at creating a true Venetian experience, by offering courses in Italian language combined with specific culture modules as well as activities that put students in direct contact with life in Venice.



Programmes

The SIE offers programmes in beginner, elementary and intermediate Italian, combined with one or two culture modules such as art history, Italian design, contemporary Venice, Italian literature and culture, and more...

Costs

2 weeks / 40 hours Italian (Beginners or Elementary)
+ 1 culture module: €1,250
3 weeks / 50 hours Italian (Intermediate)
+ 1 culture module: €1,650
Extra culture module: €170

Accommodation at a student residence or similar structure in Venice's city centre is included.

Activities

Students can also choose to participate in any of a range of activities, from a guided tour of the city to day excursions around the lagoon, from dragon-boating through the canals to Venetian cooking or mosaic decoration.
