# XIV International Symposium of the Spanish Society for the Didactics of Language and Literature (SEDLL)

The Spanish Society for the Didactics of Language and Literature (SEDLL) is pleased to announce the XIV SEDLL International Symposium, entitled New Challenges and Horizons in Research into the Didactics of Language and Literature in the Post-communicative and Emotional Era.

The Symposium is organised by the Department of Linguistics and Comparative Cultural Studies of Ca' Foscari University of Venice, in collaboration with the Spanish Society for the Didactics of Language and Literature (SEDLL), and will take place at the *Campus Treviso* of Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Treviso, Italy), from 6th to 8th April 2020.

Following recent developments in the didactics of language and literature, the XIV International Symposium of the SEDLL aims to address two innovative research perspectives that have been triggering the interest of scholars and researchers in the field of didactics, i.e. the post-communicative approach and the role of emotions in language teaching.

- deepen the renewed role of linguistic mediation in the light of the changes in the CEFR.
