

# **Programme at a glance**

The degree programme in Business Administration and Management at Ca' Foscari University's Venice School of Management has a long history dating back over 50 years as the first bachelor's degree programme established in Italy. Today, the course has over 13,000 graduates who hold high-level positions in businesses and international organisations of all shapes and sizes as a result of the training they received.

Guided by our top faculty and surrounded by leaders from the domains of business and innovation, students will have the freedom to explore the many opportunities that business administration can offer, and chart the career path that is best suited for their goals.

This three-year degree programme was designed to give students a thorough understanding of how corporate operations work. It accomplishes this by equipping students with the knowledge and skills needed to analyse and interpret business-related challenges and decision-making processes. Students will learn how to cultivate a critical thinking mindset to assist them in navigating the multidisciplinary boundaries of business organisations. Marketing, finance, banking operations, and budget creation are all disciplines that will prepare students to work effectively in a variety of professions, including international brands, multinational corporations, global financial markets, and new business ventures.

In 2019, the Italian National Agency for University System and Research (ANVUR) accredited the degree programme's quality. ANVUR does, in fact, oversee the Italian quality evaluation system for universities and research institutions.

#### "Bruna Grandese Carlotti" Scholarship

First-year students now have access to a scholarship worth 5,000 euros per year, covering the programme's three academic years, thanks to the generous contribution of the Carlotti family. The scholarship is available each year and is managed through a specific call for applications.

#### **Ecotopia Programme**

ECOTOPIA is an international training programme developed within the Eutopia project, an alliance of 10 European universities that share a vision and collaborate to build the universities of the future. It is a three-year programme that combines economics, management, finance, business, and sustainability. The programme, which is taught entirely in English, is intended for students in their first year of the Bachelor of Business Administration and Management.


