

Requirements

There are two different regulations for taking exams::

- **Mandatory priority Exams:** These exams must be taken before any other exam. Any exam taken without having first passed these priority exams will **not be taken into consideration**. These priority exams will be listed in the frequency plan of your curriculum/degree programme.
- **Prerequisites:** These courses are considered as a preliminary preparation that a student must have attended to benefit from the chosen programme. They are listed in each degree programme. The exams taken without having fulfilled these requirements will be taken into consideration unless the courses that were listed as obligatory are also mandatory priority exams.

Preliminary courses		The courses listed in the previous column are required in order to take any exam belonging to the following fields of study* (the field of study is indicated in the related syllabus)
- Additional Learning Requirement (ALR) Mathematics		First-year students cannot take any exam in the business, economic or quantitative area if they have this ALR (Additional Learning Requirement) pending. Second- or later-year students cannot take any exam at all if they have this ALR pending In the case of enrollment in years following the first, the ALR (Additional Learning Requirement) restricts access to exams in the business, economics, or quantitative areas. From the following year onward, it blocks access to all exams, regardless of the area.
