**STUDY GRANT FROM DELOITTE:  
MASTER IN SCIENCE AND MANAGEMENT OF CLIMATE  
CHANGE - A.Y. 2024-2025**

**Deloitte Climate & Sustainability Benefit Company** offers one student a contribution of € 6,000 to fully cover the tuition fee for the Master's diploma in Science and Management of Climate Change - a.y. 2025-2026.

The contribution will be granted in the form of total exemption from the payment of enrolment fees.

The student awarded with the grant will have to spend their period of internship at the company, precisely in the Sustainability 6 Climate Change team in Italy.

Requirements for the candidates:

- having duly submitted the application to the Master in Science and Management of Climate Change according with the procedures of art. 3 of the University's Call for Application within the deadline;
- being in possession of the minimum entry requirements (Master's degree);
- not receiving other fundings (public and/or private) to support their participation in the Master's programme in Science and Management of Climate Change for the academic year 2025-2026;
- having a scientific bachelor's degree, or a degree related to climate change topics;
- being available to move to a different location in Italy for the internship (the expenses for the trip will be paid by the student while costs during the internship will be covered by Deloitte; for detailed information on this regard please address the representative of Deloitte directly; contacts will be provided after the interviews).

The evaluation committee will assess the applications received according to the following criteria:

-- up to 60 points for the grade of the master's degree / *laurea del Vecchio ordinamento / specialistica* based on the grade and relevance to the themes of the Master's degree (60 points = 110L);

-- up to 10 points for previous professional experience in line with the themes of the Master's degree, also considering voluntary work and internships and study or research experience abroad;

-- up to 30 points for the oral interview, during which motivation and knowledge of the topics will be assessed.

Candidates must properly complete the online application procedure as it is described in the call: being eligible for the Master is a necessary condition to be considered for Deloitte's grant.
