

Application for single courses - Master in Science and Management of Climate Change

It is possible to apply to any course offered in the Master in Science and Management of Climate Change using the “single courses” enrolment option.

Please read the information below carefully and write to phd-climate-change@unive.it if you have any questions or need further information and, in any case, if you decide to enroll.

Note: Maximum 5 candidates enrolled as “single course” students can participate in each course.

1. For enrolment in the individual courses, the same requirements must be met as for admission to the Master.
Please contact the Master's Secretariat in advance in order to verify if your academic and professional background satisfy the admission requirements.

The registration fee for each module is € 500,00; except for the two LABS - Data, Tools and Methods for Earth Sciences which cost € 250,00 per module. Registration for both LABS (Introduction and Practicals) is compulsory.

Deadlines

September 4th 2026 for the 1st term

January 8th 2026 for the 2nd term

3. Attendance is compulsory. Only those who attained at least 80% attendance of each module will be admitted to the relative final examination, unless otherwise specified.
4. Those who successfully pass the final exam will be issued with an official certificate stating the number of credits acquired and the relevant SSD.
5. Should the candidate enrolled in single courses decide to complete the training course and obtain the degree in subsequent editions of the Master's degree, the Master's Board will assess, on a case-by-case basis, the possible exemption from attending modules already successfully completed and the reduction of the enrolment fee in accordance with the University Regulations, which provide for a maximum reduction of 20% of the enrolment fee (see “Regolamento Master universitari e delle attività di Lifelong Learning” and “Linee guida per il riconoscimento dei CFU relativi ai corsi di Master universitari” available at the page <https://wwwt.unive.it/web/it/18026/didattica-ricerca-e-terza-missione>).
