<b>Abstract</b>	<p>The Department of Management is the Lead Partner of the HI-TEACH project, funded by the Erasmus+ Programme. HI-TEACH was established in response to the critical challenges and impacts of the COVID-19 emergency on education—the most widespread in the history of teaching. This crisis forced universities worldwide to move their teaching activities online, resulting in the largest digitalization experiment ever undertaken. The project aims to create an innovative "train-the-trainer" program, designed to transform e-learning into a strategic and permanent component of education, while fostering the evolution of educators into "Hi-Teachers." A "Hi-Teacher" will be equipped to evaluate, interpret, and meet a wide range of educational needs by mastering inclusive web-based methodologies and technologies. These tools leverage audiovisual media and gaming as experimental fields to introduce flexibility, simplicity, accessibility, interactivity, and personalization into open learning. By design, the project will also foster transnational cooperation in Higher Education (HE), generating high-value relational, scientific, and methodological capital.</p>
