



Students-Professors Joint Commission

Regulation

(updated resol. no. 35/2021, October 19th, 2021)

The Students-Professors Joint Commission has tasks equivalent to the provisions of art. 37 of the University Statute for the Students-Professors Joint Commission of the Interdepartmental Schools.

1. The Students-Professors Joint Commission (from now on, CPAD – Commissione Paritetica Allievi-Docenti) contributes to the Quality Assurance (from now, QA) procedures for the activities undertaken by the Ca' Foscari International College (from now on, CFIC).

2. The CPAD operates as a permanent observatory on didactic activities, orientation, and tutoring at the CFIC.

The CPAD monitors the educational programme and the quality of teaching, as well as the tutoring assistance by professors toward students. The CPAD can select indicators (quantitative or qualitative) for the evaluation of the outcomes of the educational programme, its teaching quality and assistance to students, suggesting them to the CFIC Studies Committee or directly to the University Board of Assessment. The CPAD provides assessments on the educational activities offered by the CFIC.

3. The CPAD prepares an annual report, which takes into consideration the educational programme offered by the CFIC, with specific reference to the teaching evaluations filled out by the students. CPAD is also tasked with reporting specific problems or suggesting appropriate interventions.

4. The CPAD has a balanced representation: two professors and two students of the CFIC, one enrolled in a Bachelor's degree and one enrolled in a Master's degree.

The following roles are incompatible with the CPAD: a) Director of the CFIC; b) members of the Board of Assessment or of the University Quality Control Unit.

5. Professors are designated by the Studies Committee among its members, except for the Director. The duration of their mandate is three years.

Students are designated by the Studies Committee, after a public selection based on the applications submitted directly to the College or to the students' assembly.

A Selection Committee, made up of the Director (or his/her delegate), the Secretary (or his/her delegate) and a student nominated by the Student Representatives, draws up a ranking among the candidacies within a specific public selection in compliance with the principles of equal representation among first and second level students and, subordinately, among the disciplinary areas represented.

Candidates can be directly confirmed in case there are less than two names for each level (Bachelor's and Master's degree).

Students who have incurred into disciplinary actions are not compatible with the position. The duration of the students' mandate is two years.

The Studies Committee appoints one of the two elected professors as President of the Commission. All components are immediately renewable only once.

6. The Commission is convened by the President at least twice a year.

7. In case one of the members forfeits or resigns the mandate, replacement is provided within four months following the same procedures described above.
