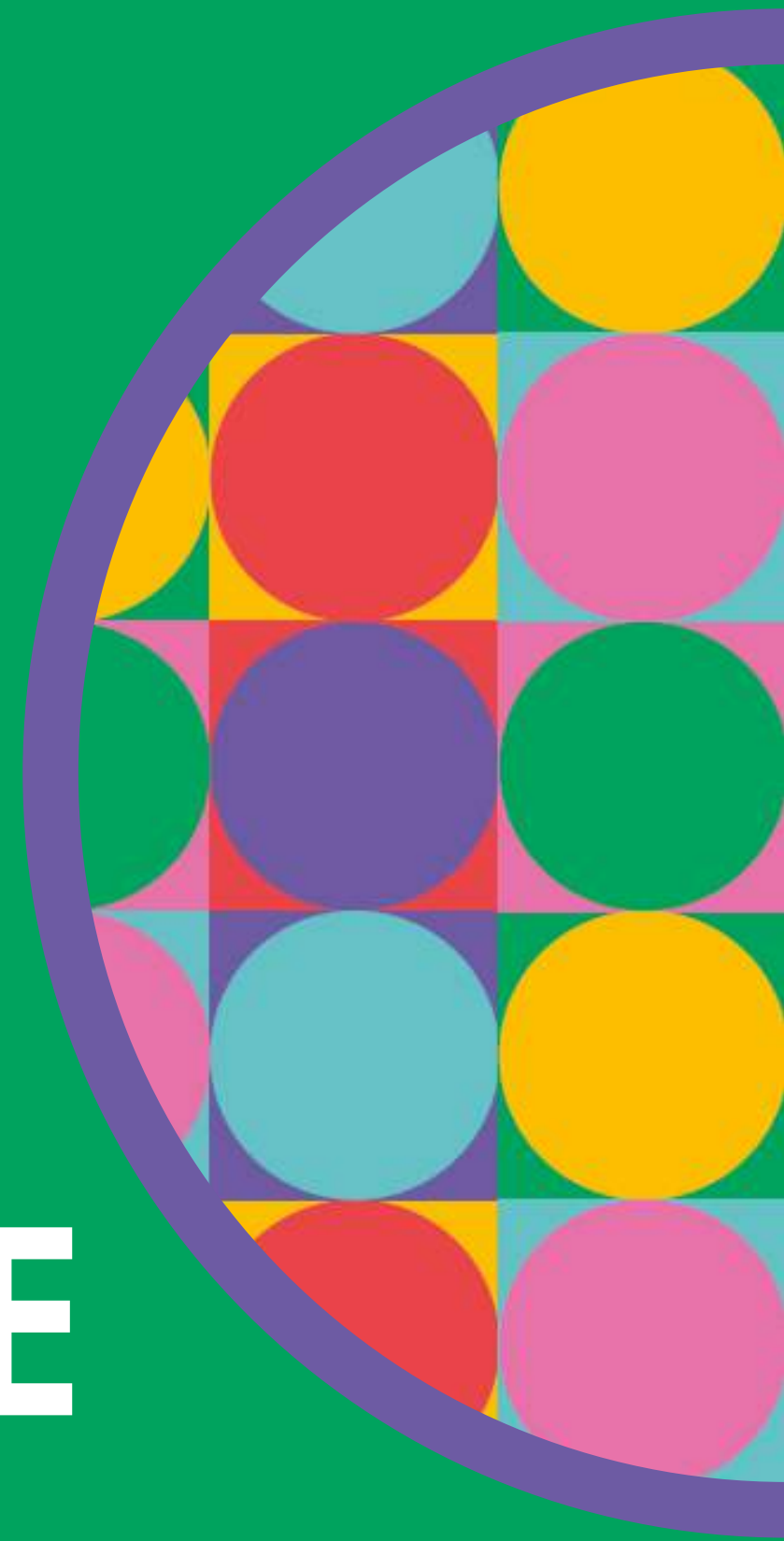

TAKING CARE OF VENICE

ETHICS AND PRACTICES OF MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND MENDING IN THE HERITAGE CITY

Taking care of Venice is a research workshop for a selected group of students from Advanced School (both 1st and 2nd cycle) and Ca' Foscari Masters programmes, led by an international faculty composed of scholars in management, cultural heritage, urban studies and sociology.

The aim of the workshop is to investigate and document through artistic languages the different '**care practices**' developed in Venice in the last decade to **preserve the city's heritage, essence and livelihood**.

These practices reflect a **bottom-up approach** that has revived interest in forgotten aspects of Venice, such as housing, migration, community practices, circular economy and urban agriculture, highlighting how the city is a fragile urban environment.

The focus is on initiatives that are simple and small in scale, whose ambition is concentrated on specific issues and locations and aimed at **channelling the concerns and efforts of residents towards activities related to maintenance, repair, and restoration**.

To investigate and document these practices, the laboratory will combine: **theoretical exploration through academic lectures and interdisciplinary class discussions** with lead scholars on topics such as the politics of care, urban cultural policies from below and art-based research methods; and **practical application, through immersive field investigations** by groups in urban initiatives of "practices of care" accompanied by an artist-mentor.

The deliverable of the research laboratory will be the groups' **final restitutions of their analysis**. These should go beyond conventional outputs, as participating students are expected to integrate the knowledge acquired through theoretical inputs and practical field investigations into a cohesive narrative, using artistic languages.
